REQUIREMENTS:

- All applicants must complete the application in its entirety.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

1. Complete the attached application form.
2. Attach Official High School transcript.
3. Submit a typewritten essay explaining the importance of a college education in today's society. The essay must be a minimum of 300 words and not more than 500 words.
4. Include two Letters of Recommendations as listed below:
 - a. One from a Teacher or Guidance Counselor
 - b. One from a Community or Religious Leader
5. Attach a copy of your Official Acceptance Letter from the College or University you plan to attend.
